

Subject: **Staus of Jaypee University of Engineering & Technology, Guna, Madhya Pradesh.**
Sir,

With reference to your letter No JUET:ADMIN:UGC:2014:824 dated 23.07.2014 and JUET:ADMIN:UGC:2014 dated 16.08.2014, I am directed to inform you as under:-

1. Jaypee University of Engineering & Technology, Guna, Madhya Pradesh was established by an Act of State Legislature of Madhya Pradesh as a Private University and is empowered to award degrees as specified under Section 22 of the UGC Act through its main campus at regular mode with the approval of Statutory Bodies/Councils, wherever its required.
2. Jaypee University of Engineering & Technology, Guna, Madhya Pradesh is not authorized to open study centre/ off campus centre beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the state as per the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of Prof. Yashpal Vs. State of Chhattisgarh. The University cannot open its centre(s) even within the state as per the provision of UGC (Establishment of and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003 without the approval of UGC.
3. The UGC has not granted any approval to the University to open off campus/study centre.
4. Further an Expert Committee of UGC along-with AICTE team visited the University on 10-12th Feb, 2012 to ascertain fulfilment of criteria by the University in terms of programmes, faculty, infrastructural facilities, financial viability, etc as laid down from time to time by the UGC and other Concerned Statutory Council(s). The Compliance submitted by the University in respect of the observation/suggestion given by the UGC Expert committee has been accepted by the UGC in its 497th meeting (Item No. 501) held on 10.01.2014.
